APPLICATION PROCESS AT SIS

SIS limits students to 10 applications worldwide. Official transcripts and letters of recommendation are sent directly to admissions offices or through CIALFO using Parchment services.

Unofficial transcripts are neither signed nor stamped; these are provided for students to self-report. SIS is a registered SAT centre for SIS students only; we do not prepare students for the SAT, nor do we report SAT data.

GRADING AND GPA


SIS reports using the 1-7 IB marking scheme. In keeping with the IB philosophy, SIS does not calculate GPA and does not rank students.


